Our values are equally simple and inspired by the community of Bedlington - that everyone is respected and valued as an individual, and that all children's futures are seen as being of equal value so that everyone is given a chance to thrive.

Children come to Bedlington Academy to learn and ultimately leave with the qualifications that give them the best chance to access further study or rewarding careers. However, we pride ourselves on the work we do not just to educate children academically, but to educate them as young citizens. We work hard to instil traditional values and important life skills across the

whole school and start by ensuring that our school is a safe and caring environment where staff are approachable and where mutual respect dominates.

AT BEDLINGTON ACADEMY WE AIM HIGH AND WE WANT EVERYONE TO KNOW ABOUT IT.

Our bottom line is that we expect all students to succeed. We don't expect them to succeed in the same way at the same things – that would be a very boring world indeed - but we do instil high aspirations and standards from day one, and work tirelessly to ensure that confidence is built, talents are nurtured, and passions are pursued.

We encourage all students, regardless of their ability, to work hard and reach their full potential by providing a challenging curriculum that allows them to stretch themselves. The transition between in-school and home learning is seamless, as with the use of Student

POD, our entire curriculum is online and all students have access to our Office 365 platforms.

For our students, we recognise that targeted support and aspirational opportunities can help them really fly high. Therefore, we focus on careers education from Year 7 onwards, with university and college visits, and work experience opportunities which are designed to enhance students' learning and boost their aspirations. In addition, in-school events enable students to get a head start in understanding the range of future choices available to them.

Creative writing

There are many opportunities for budding writers to showcase their talents, including our brilliant Year 9 students who have taken part in a Newcastle University project working with real writers to produce stunning poetry and artwork now on display in galleries across the region.

Super STEM

Five sixth form students recently won £5,000 in a national UK Space Agency competition by developing an innovative idea that used satellites to benefit humans displaced by natural disasters.

The arts

From leading roles to stagehands, our annual shows bring the whole school together to entertain our community. Our performing arts department takes part in a National Theatre project where

students work with professional directors and perform at prestigious theatres. Students can also access musical tuition and take part in orchestra and choir activities, including performing in the prestigious NELT concerts at the Sage Gateshead.

School trips

Activities further afield include cultural trips to London and Europe, and curriculum linked visits to the Lake District, Zurich and Iceland. Every year, students take part in our summer activities week which includes adventurous sports and fun days out.

Sports

Sport is important at Bedlington Academy with students' commitment and talent paying off with regular top ups of the silverware cabinet.

Community spirit

We have a strong connection with our local community and regularly support church and charity events. Every year we host an OAP Christmas dinner and Macmillan Coffee Morning.

Building character

Students have their views heard as representatives on our student council or as prefects. Our Duke of Edinburgh's Award programme allows students to gain a nationally recognised qualification whilst completing expeditions and helping the local community and environment. We also have a whole host of exciting extra-curricular clubs and activities for you to get involved with from debating to drama and sport to Spanish. Students also have the opportunity to become a member of our Combined Cadet Force, one of only two in Northumberland.

Bedlington Academy is sponsored by the North East Learning Trust (NELT), a successful family of 12 schools across the North East.

NELT has a proven track record of school improvement with all schools under their wing having sustained or improved their Ofsted gradings at their first inspection following sponsorship.

NELT is widely regarded as providing some of the best education in the county, and indeed the country, with children making significant progress from their starting points, achieving impressive exam results, and going on to access a range of well-respected further and higher education opportunities including courses at some of the UK's most elite universities.

The Trust is also heavily involved with teacher development. It boasts its very own teacher training arm, North East SCITT, that trains the next generation of teachers and ensures the highest standards of teaching are instilled from the outset. It is a National Teaching School

Hub, one of 87 centres of excellence across England that provide high quality training and development to teachers throughout their careers. Not only that, but the Trust's founding school, The Academy at Shotton Hall, is a National Research School, one of just 23 in England, that up-skill teachers using cutting-edge research.
